SYSTEMS: WORSHIP MINISTRY SYSTEMS

Communication

Communication is intertwined in every aspect of your ministry. It's really a series of systems. Ask these two questions about communication system(s) in your ministry:

- How do I disseminate schedules and other important information to team members?
- How would I describe my team's responsiveness to that communication?

Scheduling

Does my current scheduling system

- force me to chase people down?
- allow no-shows and last minute call-offs?
- encourage team members to take responsibility for their schedule?

Qualification System

- Does my qualification system allow only the right people to "on the bus"?
- Does my qualification system reinforce and teach the values of the team to new musicians & techs?

Music/Service Planning

• Does my system for planning music give team members a chance to prepare well ahead of rehearsal?

Other Worship Systems include: training and team development, team member evaluations, leadership development, rehearsals & sound-checks, etc.

SYSTEMS:

DEVELOPING YOUR MINISTRY SYSTEMS

For each area of ministry, ask these questions:

- What do I not like about my ministry right now and what do I want it to look like?
- What is the current system in this part of my ministry?
- What part of the current system is producing what I don't like?
- What do I need to change in the system to make it produce what I want it to?
- With the new system, ask:
 - What can only I do?
 - Who can assist me and eventually take over? (Remember the 80% rule: if someone can do something 80% as good as you, let them.)
 - What is success and how do I measure it?

Don't try to overhaul every area of your ministry at once.
