Module 7: Avoiding The Rookie Mistakes of Practicing

P - Playing, Not Practicing

R - Rehearse (or Real)

E - Enough - playing it once and calling it good enough.

P - Practicing Without A Click

A - Alone - can play the song OK “alone” by not with band

R - Rut - “practice makes....*permanent.*”

Practice the right stuff to get the right rut.

E - Excessive

D - Detours:

If we're going to practice effectively, in LESS TIME, we've got to keep focused.

Excuses

- MOST of the time, we don't get our practice in because **we failed to plan ahead and take control of our own schedules.**
- Being a valuable team member on your worship team means **OWNING** your responsibility to practice.
- If you truly are too busy to practice during the week, it means you're too busy to serve on the worship team.
